TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC

Welton Road, Brough (part of):

Water Lane Elloughton (part of):

Welton Low Road Elloughton (part of):

Notice is hereby given that The East Riding of Yorkshire Council intends not less than seven days from the date of this notice to make an Order, the effect of which will be to prohibit any vehicle from proceeding along the following:

Welton Low Road Elloughton - between the junction with Lowerdale and the junction traffic lights with Welton Road.

Welton Road Brough - extending from north of Loxley Way to north of Cowgate Welton

Water Lane - from the junction with Welton Road to Stanley Jackson Way.

commencing 19th March 2019 to allow carriageway reconstruction works to take place.

The working hours will be between 21:00hrs and 05:00hrs only.

The road closure is necessary to enable the works to be carried out in a manner consistent with ensuring the safety of the public. The Order is valid for 18 months, but it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 3rd April 2019.

The alternative route for traffic affected by the road closure will as follows:

Access or egress Stanley Jackson Way and Common Lane:

Access is via the A63 Welton Interchange from the westbound carriageway of the A63. For vehicles approaching from the west and wishing to access Stanley Jackson Way or Common Lane the diversion route is:

A63 eastbound, Melton Interchange, A63 westbound to Welton Interchange.

For vehicles exiting Stanley Jackson Way or Common Lane and wishing to travel eastbound,

the diversion route is:

Welton Interchange, A63 westbound South Cave interchange A63 eastbound.

For Brough traffic the diversion route is:

Welton Road, Cave Road, Stockbridge Road Roundabout, Roman Road, South Cave interchange and vice versa.

For Elloughton traffic the diversion route is:

Welton Low Road, Stockbridge Road, Stockbridge Road Roundabout, South Cave Interchange and vice versa.

All diversion routes will be signed at the time of closure. The road will be closed to all traffic but access will be maintained for residents, emergency services and pedestrians.
