ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 SECTION 14 (1)
TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF PEDESTRIAN TRAFFIC
Petuaria Way Footpath, Welton (Part of)

Notice is hereby given that The East Riding of Yorkshire Council intends not less than seven days from the date of this notice to make an Order, the effect of which will be to prohibit any persons from proceeding along part of Petuaria Way Footpath, Welton (Between Cowgate and Beck Lane Footpath, adjacent to the A63) commencing the 14th November 2022 to allow for excavation works to be carried out for utility installation. - Gas, electric and water supplies are to be installed.

The footpath closure is necessary to enable the works to be carried out in a manner consistent with ensuring the safety of the public. The Order is valid for 18 months, but it is anticipated that the works will be completed within 7 days.

The works are to be carried out between the hours of 09:00 - 15:00. The footpath will then be made safe for pedestrians to use outside of these working hours.

The alternative route for pedestrians affected by the closure will be via:

Cowgate, The Green, Church Street, Beck Lane Footpath and vice versa.

The diversion route will be signed at the time of closure. The footpath will be closed to all pedestrians but access will be maintained for emergency services at all times.
