The reference number is 18/03116/CM.****

As a reminder, the other relevant planning applications are:

- 18/00703/CM **Energy from Waste plant** Approved in principle but not yet signed off
- 18/02749/CM **Increases working hours at Transwaste from 76 to 168 a week** Pending
- 18/02544/CM **20 x 1 MW gas burning generators** Pending
